All of the articles in this proceedings volume have been presented at the *International Conference on Computer, Information Technology and Intelligent Computing 2022 (CITIC 2022)* during 25th–27th July 2022 in *Multimedia University, Cyberjaya, Malaysia (online)*. These articles have been peer reviewed by the members of the *Technical Committee* and approved by the Editor-in-Chief, who affirms that this document is a truthful description of the conference’s review process.

1 Review Procedure

The reviews were *double-blind*. Each submission was examined by *at least 3* reviewer(s) independently.

The conference submission management system was EDAS Conference and Journal Management System that manages the paper submission, review and registration process for conferences.

The submissions were first screened for generic quality and suitability by the Technical Chair. After the initial screening, they were sent for peer review by matching each paper’s topic with the reviewers’ expertise, taking into account any competing interests. A paper could only be considered for acceptance if it had received favourable recommendations from at least two reviewers. The acceptance or rejection of a revised manuscript was final.

2 Quality Criteria

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions:

1. Pertinence of the article’s content to the scope and themes of the conference;
2. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
3. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
4. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
5. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher.
